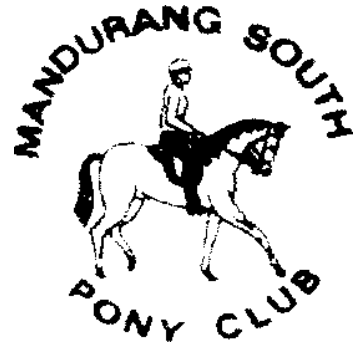

## WELCOME TO MANDURANG SOUTH PONY CLUB

Established in 1977 the club holds rallies every **FIRST SUNDAY** of each month at Mandurang South Recreation Reserve, Hannans Road, Mandurang South, except January.

All riders should be at the grounds ready for gear check by 9.30am for a 10am start. The day ends at 3.30pm.

In case of inclement weather a decision is made by 8am. In this case a theory day is held in the hall. Telephone the Secretary, President or D.C for a decision. Every member is responsible for ensuring that their PCAV card is signed at each rally by the Secretary.

**All parents are expected to assist in setting up and dismantling of equipment used at the rallies, attend working bees prior to events and to assist on competition days.**

UNIFORM: Crash cap Australian standards number AS/NZS3838 or EN1384 or ASTM F1163

Short leather riding boots, fully soled in smooth rubber or leather, or long boots.

Bone/ Banana coloured jodhpurs, white shirt, red tie, club jumper (brown with red sash) or windcheater, or polo top and windcheater (if necessary).

Black or brown chaps to match short boots are allowed at rallies but not competitions.

HORSE AND EQUIPMENT: Prior to each rally a gear check is undertaken to make sure all gear is safe and correctly fitted. Please be aware of gear rules. Horses should be in good condition and well groomed.

### FEES

- **240 Junior member (additional family members \$230 ea) - Jnr member under 17 yrs**
- **\$260 Senior member (additional family members \$250 ea) - Snr member over 17 yrs**

This amount includes a monthly newsletter, PCAV fees and insurance for the financial year (July to June). Fees are payable in May of each year. If you have difficulty with payment please talk to our Treasurer to organize alternative arrangements.

CATERING AT RALLIES: A BBQ is lit at all rallies so please BYO food to cook. Hot water is available for drinks. At club events a canteen is run with donations from all Pony Club members.

**PARENTAL SUPERVISION:** All parents are required to fully supervise their children at all times. If a parent is not able to be present at the rally another adult, who is prepared to be responsible, must be organized prior to the rally.

CLUB MEETINGS: These are held at the hall at the Recreation Reserve at 8pm on the 3<sup>rd</sup> **Thursday** of each month. The A.G.M is normally held in April, where all positions are declared vacant. All parents are encouraged to join the committee and attend meetings.
